Description

Haven is the Gallatin Valley's non-profit serving survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, and sex trafficking. Founded in 1979, Haven provides a 24-hour support line, emergency shelter, legal advocacy, counseling, and support groups for survivors of family violence. Haven also works towards prevention and education.

Options

- Event Support: We need help with different donor appreciation events happening throughout the year like delivering flowers, thank you notes, etc. We ask that anyone under 15 be accompanied by a parent or guardian on these deliveries.
- Fundraiser/Donation Drives: Another option is to host a fundraiser or donation drive for Haven of items that survivors and their families might need. These events also help raise awareness about Haven.
- Peer Education: If you're interested in supporting and teaching your friends and/or classmates about healthy relationships and reproductive health, we welcome you to consider becoming a Peer Educator at the high school level. This program has a formal application and selection process that happens usually in the spring around mid-April. Please contact us for more details!
- Internship: We are always open to ideas you might have for an internship. We have various one-time project needs on our development and fundraising team and are happy to connect with you more about how you might like to develop your skills and support Haven.
